Hopefully their efforts will provide some sense of normalcy and comfort to our students during the coming weeks.

Here are some important things to note:

- There will be NO athletics, extracurricular activities, or practices during the closure.
- Lessons will be posted each school day, so please make sure your child is working throughout the next two weeks. Teachers will be checking in with students and parents to see if you need help with anything.
- Please remind your student to use their chromebook for instructional purposes only.
 Our GoGuardian alert system will remain active throughout the closure. This system sends administration an email if students access inappropriate sites.
- We are still planning to take all May field trips at this time. As we get closer to the date, we will evaluate the situation and be in contact with you if anything changes.
- Spring Break is March 30- April 4. These are planned days off and no digital learning will occur during this time.

On Monday, March 16th, the system will distribute meals at each high school from 8:30 – 10:30 a.m. The plan for the first week is to provide breakfast and lunch for two days on Monday, and to provide meals for three days on Wednesday, March 18.

On Monday, March 23rd, the system will provide breakfasts and lunches for the week, also distributed from the systems' three high schools.

We plan to resume face-to-face classes on Monday, April 6th.
